Sports Update

This term in sport, Villiers have continued their fine form in both football leagues. In the mixed league, the team have won 3 out of 3 fixtures, putting them in a great position to win the league and progress to the Wolverhampton Championships. The girls have also done extremely well, winning 4 games, and drawing 1.

The mixed team also made it to the finals of the Blakemore Cup, losing only on penalties in the final.

In athletics, Villiers took gold in the Bilston Championships, with both girls and boys teams achieving 1st place.

Soccer 2000 have also been bought in to provide lunchtime football clubs to year 3 and 5.

Year 3 and 4 competed in a SEN football competition and came out winners of the tournament. SEN table cricket was introduced, where children were given sessions in afternoons. Some children were then chosen to represent the school in an external competition.
